SHILLONG, MAR 3: The Sub Divisional Magistrate, Sohra Civil Sub Division, Sohra has promulgated an Order under Section 144 CrPC prohibiting person or group of persons or organizations from indulging in any activities of any kind in the whole stretch of the rivers namely, Shella Umiyam and Thariaghat and within 100 meters on both sides of the said river banks.

This order has been issued in view of the information received that there is all likelihood of extraction of boulder and sand from the river beds of Shella Umiyam and Thariaghat by individuals or groups residing in the vicinity on the ground that the water level during February to May becomes low in both the rivers, an official release said.

This order comes into force with immediate effect for a period of six months until further orders.
